CONNERMARA 12YR PEATED · 20

Named after the rugged Atlantic coastal region, Connermara Peated Single Malt is one of just a few Irish whiskies that have revived the tradition of drying the malted barley over peat fires. The peat smoke rising through the malt guilds, dry out the barley creating layers of complexity in the whisky. The whiskey is then aged 12 years in ex-bourbon barrels at an easy drinking 80 proof.

Walter Teeling in 1792 established a distillery on Marrowbone Lane in Dublin, Ireland in what's known as the "golden triangle" and later to be called Cooley Distillery. Later Cooley Distillery was bought out by the more well known company William Jameson & Co. whom was also located on Marrowbone Street, but had to close in the early 20th century due to financial difficulties. In 2015, Jack and Stephan Teeling re-opened to what is now Teeling Whiskey Company and it is the first distillery in Dublin in 125 years.
